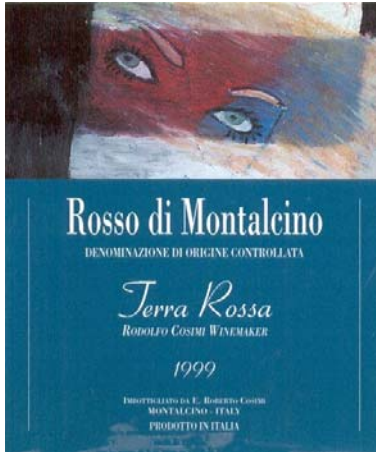

May Wine Club Wines

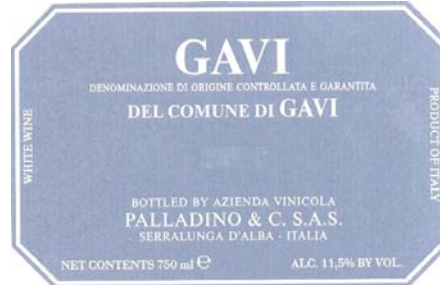
1999 Terra Rossa Rosso di Montalcino Tuscany, Italy



100% Sangiovese Grosso from Tuscany. One of the most important things about this Rosso is that it comes from the same vineyard as the Brunello di Montalcino. In a normal vintage, the total production is about 1000 cases between the two wines. The owner/winemaker, Rudi Cosimi, ferments the high quality grapes in new wood vats, then it's aged in French wood for a minimum of 12 months before bottle aging.

A full bodied wine with dried berry fruit flavors and an elegant finish. Sangiovese screams out for roasted meats, polenta and wild mushrooms! Still, you can do any red sauced pasta, or meats with red sauce - even cream sauces - it's wonderful with full flavored aged cheeses like fontina, parmigiano reggiano.

2002 Palladino Gavi di Gavi, Italy



The grape is Gavi Cortese 'cor-tay-zah', and it is very crisp and delicate with subtle citrus flavors. It sees no oak. It may be called Gavi, Gavi di Gavi, or Cortese di Gavi, depending on the

producer. Gavi is located in the Piedmont region of Northwestern Italy and is considered one of the noblest whites produced in the country. This wine comes from Serralunga d'Alba, a prime area for Barolo as well. Gavi is meant for seafood - scallops, clams and mussels, and fin fish. It also goes great with cream sauces due to high acidity. A lighter tomato based sauce is fine - as long as it is fresh tomatoes, not long simmered. Only 4,000 cases are produced.

May Winery—Pirtle Winery - Weston, Missouri



In July of 1978, the Pirtle Winery was established in historic Weston,

Missouri. Presently, they are a small, quality-oriented winery, allowing them to give a great deal of personal attention to their wines. They believe this attention to detail is why they have award-winning wines that can hold their own against others from the US and around the world. The winery building is in a former Lutheran Evangelical Church that was built by German immigrants in 1867. Wine production takes place in the press house, which is on the bottom floor of



the building. The tasting room and store are on the second floor, and a vine-covered wine garden is between the winery building and press house. They are family-owned and operated and produce superior quality wines with a great deal of character and individuality. Drop by
