2002 GUSTAVE LORENTZ GEWURZTRAMINER Bergheim, Alsace, France

The Lorentz family has been growing grapes in the Alsace area for over 250 years, with vineyard sites in the famous Grand Cru vineyards of Altenberg de Bergheim and Kanzlerberg. The family tradition has been handed down unchanged from father to son, in spite of all the vagaries of history. Each new generation has respected the tradition, adding just the right measure of imagination needed to develop the Lorentz company and bring it in line with the times. This is the task undertaken by Georges Lorentz, the current Managing Director of the company. This Gewurztraminer hails from the sunny South/South-East facing slopes of Bergheim. “Gewurz” in German means spice. In fact, the Gewurztraminer has a nose brimming with fruit and spice, and is rich and full in the mouth. It is traditionally enjoyed as an aperitif, with strong cheese (muenster or roquefort), or with desserts. It goes beautifully with lobster in sauce and even game birds (i.e. **TURKEY**). The Gewurztraminer is very pleasant in its youth and has excellent aging potential (10 to 15 years in the best years). 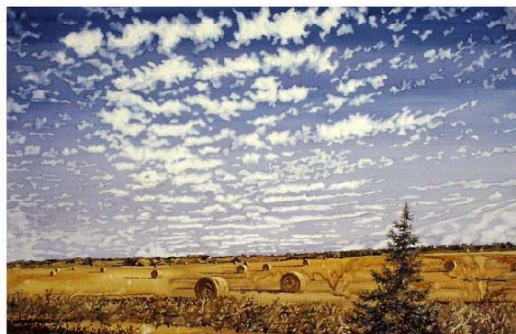
2002 HERON PINOT NOIR, California

Laely Heron was raised by unconventional parents, and has lived an unconventional life in Africa, Asia, Europe and the U.S. She spent the first three and a half decades of her life fulfilling her appetite for adventure, her thirst for risk taking, and her endless curiosity in places, people and things that offer what she describes simply as “something more”. As a college student in Colorado, Laely spent a year in France, became fluent in the language, and later returned to enroll in the Institute of Enology to learn all she could about winemaking. A new wine from Laely is this Pinot Noir. It is made from grapes grown in Carneros and Mendocino, areas known for their long, cool growing season. This medium-bodied wine is true to the varietal: well balanced, neatly textured, firm and delicate. Aromas of plums and strawberries are followed by an attractive dried fruit flavor, leading to a smooth finish and a lively aftertaste. Enjoy with salmon, pork or **TURKEY**. Drink now. November Winery—Amphora Winery, Dry Creek, Sonoma, California

Amphora



Over the past 28 years, Rick Hutchinson has learned the art of winemaking "from the ground up". Working alongside some of the best people in the business, he has helped to transform the fine wine grapes of Sonoma County into world-class wines. In 1997, he crushed the first vintage for his own



label, Amphora. Amphorae (literally "the vine-bearer") were the clay wine vessels of the ancient Mediterranean. Rick chose the name in honor of his other passion, the art of pottery. He sees many parallels between the art of winemaking and the crafting of fine pottery: both are products of the earth, molded by the human hand, and brought to their highest expression by painstaking attention to detail.

The amphoras depicted on the labels of their wines are some of Rick's prized pieces, and a reflection of his dedication to quality.

Rick was at Wines by Jennifer on October 15th and sampled his entire line of wonderful wines. If you missed out - Rick will be back in the Spring of 2005!
