2003 HUBER GRUNER VELTLINER HUGO Traisental, Austria



Spring is just around the corner and the Wines by Jennifer staff thought this beautiful springy label would kick start your spring fever. This family estate has been growing grapes since 1778. Young Markus Huber is the latest family member to vinify wine at their winery in the Traisental area. Markus Huber, who at a mere 23 years of age, has already won the acclaim of his peers with the Winemaker of the Year title in 2002! This is a bright, clean example of the local grape, Gruner Veltliner (aka "Gru V"—as in “groovy”). The wine has delicate, fresh green apple aromas displaying flavors of lemon, lime, and peaches, a crisp and spicy palate, highly stimulating, with a beautiful length and mineral tones. Ideal for seafood and light fish, white meats, sushi, cold veggies, and light dishes like salads and pasta primavera; also very pleasant as a refreshing spring wine on a warm day by itself. Drink between 2004 – 2006.

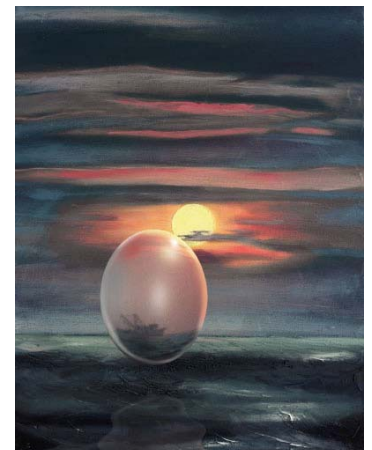
2001 VINHA DA PALESTRA Douro Valley, Portugal



This wine comes from the dynamic Dão Sul Company, voted producer of the year 2001 by a leading Portuguese wine magazine. Produced in Portugal’s famed Douro Valley, Vinha da Palestra is a blend of the Portuguese grapes Touriga Franca (Cabernet Franc), Tinta Barroca, and Tinta Rouriz (Tempranillo). Aged in French barriques, this medium-bodied red is a wine of both complexity and finesse. It features a brilliant ruby color and a fruit-forward berry and mineral nose, accented by pleasant oak spices. Lengthy on the finish and firm, but fruity in the mouth, Vinha da Palestra is a marriage of modern techniques and traditional varietals resulting in a nice, everyday wine that goes well with a wide range of foods, such as red meats, tuna steak, stews, hard cheeses and even by itself.

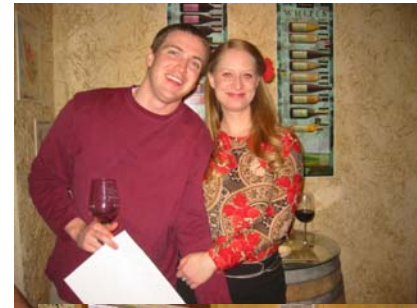
